The Mandatory Continuous Public Procurement Capacity Development Training Programme (MCPPCDTP) is a strategic initiative of the Federal Government of Nigeria aimed at strengthening institutional and professional capacity within the procurement cadre of the Federal Public Service, in line with the provisions of Part II, Sections 5(k) and 5(s) of the Public Procurement Act, 2007.

2. In furtherance of this statutory mandate, the Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) successfully conducted a Special MCPPCDTP (Conversion Training) for Senior Officers of the Nigerian Navy at the Nigerian Navy Logistics College (NNLC), Dawakin Tofa, Kano State, from 3rd to 9th May, 2026.

3. The training programme brought together Senior Officers drawn from various Commands of the Nigerian Navy and was designed to enhance participants' knowledge, competence, and professional understanding of public procurement principles, processes, and regulatory frameworks in accordance with national procurement standards and best practices. Following the successful completion of the training and the prescribed assessment exercise, the 20 participated officers were successful in the examination.

Please note that:

- Details of the result shall be formally communicated to the Chief of the Naval Staff and the commandant Nigerian Navy Logistics College.
- With respect to the collection of certificates, every successful candidate shall present;
 - i. An official staff identity card.
 - ii. Where a candidate requires a representative to collect his/her certificate, the representative shall present a Letter of Authorization duly signed by the candidate along with photocopy of the candidate's ID.
- The Accounting Officer shall ensure strict compliance with the Office of the Secretary to the Government of the Federation (OSGF) Circulars Ref. No. 597/80/S.1/T.1/117 dated 14th June, 2017, **on the prohibition of uncertified Procurement Officers from handling procurement processes** and the redeployment of Bureau-trained and certified procurement officers, as well as Circular Ref. No. 597/80/S.2/B/570 dated 9th December, 2025. In this regard, Officers who have successfully passed the prescribed Procurement Examination should be converted and redeployed to the Procurement Department/Unit in line with the approved Scheme of Service for Officers and Executive Officers Cadres.
- All candidates, including those who were unsuccessful, are required to enroll in the Nigerian Public Procurement Certification Programme (NPPCP) and register on the National Procurement Officers Management System (NAPOMS) at BPP website.
