**COMMENCEMENT OF POST-DEPLOYMENT VERIFICATION
EXERCISE FOR REDEPLOYED PROCUREMENT OFFICERS
(SGL 15-17)**

Sequel to the Bureau's circular Ref No. **BPP/DG/2026/M/20** dated March 23, 2026 on the Deployment of Procurement Officers on Salary Grade Levels 15-17 in the Federal Civil Service, a comprehensive physical Post-Deployment Verification Exercise has been scheduled to commence on Tuesday, 30th June, 2026.

2 The exercise is designed to verify the physical assumption of duties to new posts by all recently redeployed Procurement Officers across various MDAs.

3 In view of the importance of this exercise all concerned Procurement Officers (SGL 15-17) are strictly required to have concluded the process of handing and taking over of schedules accordingly.
